

**MINUTES
CITY OF NEGAUNEE SPECIAL MEETING
MAY 14, 2008**

A Special Meeting of the Negaunee City Council was held on Wednesday, May 14, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. in the Michigan Room of City Hall.

Members Present: Mayor Peterson, Council Member Thomas, Stanaway, Perucco, Gravedoni, and Wills

Members Absent: Council Member Wickstrom

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A motion was made by Council Member Gravedoni, supported by Council Member Thomas and unanimously carried to approve the agenda as presented.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No one from the Council wished to comment at this time.

SANITARY SEWER TRANSMISSION LINE TO ISHPEMING

City staff received a letter from the City of Ishpeming approving the concept of allowing the City of Negaunee to construct a sewer main through the City of Ishpeming to the Ishpeming Area Joint Wastewater Treatment Facility. The letter also contained concerns, comments, and questions raised by the Ishpeming City Council. City Manager Peterson stated that he would like the Council to go through each statement and give an answer to be able to reply to this letter.

The Council discussed each statement and decided on a response for each.

A motion was made by Council Member Thomas, supported by Council Member Gravedoni and unanimously carried to direct the City Manager to write up a response to the Ishpeming questions and schedule a meeting to discuss prior to sending the letter to Ishpeming.

SALE OF PROPERTY

City Manager Peterson stated that there are seven parcels of land behind M-28 that has just been cleared that could potentially be sold for development.

A motion was made by Council Member Thomas, supported by Council Member Wills to hold a Special Meeting on May 29th at 4:30 p.m. to walk the seven parcels of land.

GRANT APPLICATION TO MDOT LOCAL BRIDGE PROGRAM

A motion was made by Council Member Perucco, supported by Council Member Stanaway and unanimously carried to submission of up to a \$150,000 grant to MDOT under the Local Bridge Program and for the City Manager to sign the grant.

PUBLIC COMMENT

COUNCIL COMMENTS

Council Member Gravedoni asked that the ATV Ordinance be reviewed to allow ATV's to use the streets at any time.

Council Member Stanaway asked that there be signage in Old Towne regarding vandalism.
