2008 SPRING CLEANUP SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURES
RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE CUSTOMERS

The City of Negaunee and Great American Disposal will provide a dumpsite at the end of Lincoln Street during the weeks of May 19, 2008 through June 2, 2008 using the following procedures:

- The drop-off site will be closed Monday, May 26, 2008, for Memorial Day.
- Facility will open daily from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm
- Customers will be responsible for unloading their own refuse.
- Customers must present their City of Negaunee utility bill showing payment of a City Garbage Collection Fee and a driver's license confirming their City of Negaunee residence.
- A limit of 1 (ONE) PICK UP LOAD per customer will be strictly enforced.

Examples of items which can be dropped off include chairs, mattresses, sofas, washers, dryers, toilets, sinks, rugs, carpets, glass, old flooring, doors, television sets, stereos, radios, lamps, clothes, etc.

**NO BUILDING MATERIALS, APPLIANCES WHICH CONTAIN FREON,
OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Elderly residents who are discarding large metal items or appliance may have them picked up but you must telephone GAD at 475-5260 during the week of May 19, 2008 to make an appointment for removal.

Residents requesting tires to be picked up must telephone the Negaunee Public Works Department between the hours of 7:00 am – 3:00 pm at 475-9991 during the week of May 19, 2008 to make an appointment for removal. (Fees for tires are \$3.00 without a rim and \$5.00 with a rim). Residents will be charged on their city utility bill for tires picked up. No tires over the size of 16.5" will be accepted.

Compost materials weighing 50 pounds or less will be picked up for the elderly or physically challenged residents only. (Leaves and grass clippings must be bagged and sealed in bags weighing 50 pounds or less. Brush and sticks must be neatly stacked with all butt ends in a single direction.) Appointments for this collection must be made during the week of May 19, 2008 by telephoning the Public Works Department at 475-9991 between the hours of 7:00 am – 3:00 pm.

CITY OF NEGAUNEE COMPOST SITE

The City of Negaunee's compost site (located on County Road 480 across from the Wastewater Treatment Plant) will open daily beginning APRIL 21, 2008. The area will be monitored by the Negaunee Police Department.

Scheduled hours are from dawn to dusk. Please note that the site may be closed during inclement weather. If the gate is closed DO NOT leave any materials by the gate. Violators will fined.

The compost site will accept grass clippings, sod, and garden debris, brush, and tree limbs up to 12" in diameter. Bags must be emptied and placed in the trash cans provided.

Dumping of building materials, trash, garbage or other debris is prohibited; individuals caught dumping these items in this area will be fined.

CITY OF NEGAUNEE REFUSE DROP OFF SITE

Great American Disposal provides a refuse drop off site for City of Negaunee residential garbage customers to dispose of spring cleanup-type items. This service is provided on the second Thursday of each month from 12:00 Noon to 6:00 pm at the east end of Lincoln Street.

Photo identification and a current Negaunee utility bill showing the garbage collection fees will be required to dispose of materials at this site. Quantities are limited to one pickup load per month, with a maximum of four loads per household per calendar year.
