# City offers spring clean-up schedule, procedures

## *Residential Garbage Customers*

The City of Negaunee and Great American Disposal (GAD) will provide a dumpster from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on May 3 through May 15 at the east end of Lincoln Street, using the following procedures:

- Customers will be responsible for unloading their own refuse.

- Customers must present their City of Negaunee utility bill showing payment of a City Garbage Collection Fee and their driver's license confirming their City of Negaunee residency.

- The limit of one pick-up load per customer will be strictly enforced.

- Examples of items that can be dropped off include chairs, mattresses, sofas, washers, dryers, toilets, sinks, rugs, carpets, glass, old flooring, doors, television sets, stereos, radios, lamps, clothes, etc.

- No building materials, appliances that contain Freon, or hazardous materials will be accepted.

- Elderly residents who are discarding large metal items or appliances may have them picked up by GAD. These residents must call GAD at 475-5260 during the week of May 3 to make an appointment for

removal.

- Residents requesting tires to be picked up must call the Negaunee Public Works Department at 475-9991, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. during the week of May 3 to make an appointment for removal. Fees for tires are \$3 without a rim and \$5 with a rim. Residents will be charged on their city utility bill for the tires picked up. No tires larger than 16.5 inches will be accepted.

- Elderly or physically challenged residents can have their compost materials picked up. Materials such as leaves and grass clippings must be bagged and sealed in bags weighing less than 50 pounds. Brush and sticks must be neatly stacked with all butt ends in a single direction. Residents requesting compost to be picked up must call the Negaunee Public Works Department at 475-9991, between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. during the week of May 3 to make an appointment for removal.

## *City of Negaunee Compost Site*

The City of Negaunee's compost site (located on County Road 480 across from the Wastewater Treatment Plant) will be open daily. Scheduled hours are from dawn

to dusk. Please note the site may be inaccessible during inclement weather.

The compost site will accept grass clippings, sod, garden debris and brush and tree limbs up to six inches in diameter. Please empty any bags and place them in the trash cans provided. Dumping of compost materials by the entrance gates or along the roadway is prohibited. Individuals caught dumping in this area will be fined.

## *City of Negaunee Refuse Drop-Off Site*

Great American Disposal provides a refuse drop-off site for City of Negaunee residential garbage customers. This site is open the second Thursday of each month (except in May) from noon to 6:00 p.m. and is located at the east end of Lincoln Street. Acceptable items for this service are the same as allowed during spring clean-up.

Customers must present their City of Negaunee utility bill showing payment of a City Garbage Collection Fee and their driver's license confirming their City of Negaunee residency.

Quantities are limited to one pickup load per month, with a maximum of four loads per household per calendar year.
