Major Points of the New ATV Ordinance

Where Can I Operate ATVs?

- All city streets and alleys that have not been specifically prohibited by Resolution of the City Council for the purpose of accessing designated ATV trails.

What is an ATV?

- 3- or 4-wheeled vehicle designed for off-road use that has low pressure tires, a seat designed to be straddled by the rider, and is powered by a 50cc to 500cc gas engine.

What Areas Are Prohibited?

Red areas on map ~~~~~>

- Iron Street
- US-41
- BR-28

When Can I Operate ATVs?

ATVs may only be operated within the City between the hours of 8am and 8pm.

Speed is not to exceed **5mph** & ATVs are to travel single file with the flow of traffic.

Each violation is a civil infraction punishable by fines up to \$100 plus the cost of prosecution.

All State regulations regarding ATV use also apply.

Other prohibited areas include City owned parks, natural areas and cemetery properties within the City. ATVs are not to be operated on any state or federal highway, or on any part of a highway normally occupied by ditches, front/back slopes or utilities.

*****EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE: OCTOBER 10TH, 2005 *****

The City Council retains the right to revoke ATV designation on any highway, street or alley under its jurisdiction with or without cause and such prohibition shall become effective immediately.

The ordinance in its entirety will soon be available online, and at both the Police Department and City Hall offices.
