

WHERE CAN I OPERATE ATVs?

You may operate on all city streets and alleys that have not been specifically prohibited by Resolution of the City Council for the purpose of accessing designated ATV trails. **You may not use an ATV for general travel around the City. The ordinance is for direct travel to and from trail access points only.**

WHAT IS AN ATV?

An ATV is defined as a 3- or 4-wheeled vehicle designed for off-road use that has low pressure tires, a seat designed to be

straddled by the rider and is powered by a 50cc to 500cc gas engine.

WHAT AREAS ARE PROHIBITED?

Iron Street
US-41 and BR-28
City-owned parks
Natural areas
Cemetery

ATVs are not to be operated on any State or Federal highway, or on any part of a highway normally occupied by ditches, front/back slopes or utilities.

WHEN CAN I OPERATE ATVs?

ATVs may only be operated within the City between the hours of 8am and 8pm.

Speed is not to exceed 5mph and ATVs are to travel single file with the flow of traffic.

All State regulations regarding ATV use also apply.

Each violation is a civil infraction punishable by fines up to \$100 plus the cost of prosecution.
