1064.09 NON-ELECTRIC MOTORS PROHIBITED

No watercraft, vehicle or machine of any kind, having or containing a motor or engine of any kind, other than an electric motor or engine, shall be used in or upon the waters of Teal Lake.

1064.10 LAUNCHING OF NON-ELECTRIC WATERCRAFT FROM PUBLIC PROPERTY PROHIBITED

No person shall launch into Teal Lake from public property any watercraft, vehicle or machine of any kind, having or containing a motor or engine of any kind, other than an electric motor or engine.

1064.11 PROMULGATION OF RULES FOR USE OF BEACH AREA

The City’s Recreation and Parks Commission shall promulgate Rules governing the use of the beach and waterfront in the Limited Control Area, which shall be approved annually by the City Council at, or prior to, its April Regular Meeting. Once the rules are approved by City Council resolution, they shall be publicly posted at the entrance to the Limited Control Area and copies shall be maintained and made available to the public by the City Clerk. Any violation of these rules shall be considered a civil infraction. [Effective June 1st, 2004]
