Re: Water Tank Isolation Valves

BACKGROUND:

The City of Negaunee Water/Sewer Department has tried to isolate the water tank for the contractor to perform necessary preventative maintenance and painting on the Water Tank. The Water Tank receives water through a watermain connected to the 16-inch main along Teal Lake Ave. The current 2 valves on the watermain do not work in proper fashion. Without working valves, there are no logical means to isolate the water tank.

Negaunee has reached out to contractors and vendors to perform replacement of the 2 valves, below is a table summarizing the costs:

The work is expected to take place from July 31st and be completed by August 18th.

Painting and repairs of the water tank has been put on hold until this isolation project is completed.

This repair is not budgeted.

RECOMMENDATION: To waive the bidding process for this emergency repair and approve this expenditures up to \$180,000 for the Water Tank Isolation Valves near Teal Lake Ave with a drawdown of the Water Fund.
