BACKGROUND:

The City of Negaunee's sanitary sewer system near Buffalo Road has a substantial amount of infiltration and inflow. The excess groundwater and stormwater that is collected by the old sewer pipes eventually makes its way to our Buffalo lift station, jeopardizing our pumps and threatening our system's integrity.

City Staff solicited bids and one bid was received.

Re: Bluff Street Water Line

BACKGROUND:

The City of Negaunee's Water Department issued bids to perform replacement of a 1.5" galvanized water line that serves 2 properties north of Bluff Street. The replacement would involve replacing the galvanized line with two 1" copper water lines.

ANALYSIS:

Three bids were received

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended from the Public Works Department that the City accept the low bidder Smith Construction in the amount of \$28,950.00 with monies coming from the Water Fund Service Line Replacement line 591-630-968.000.

FISCAL EFFECTS:

For 2022, \$150,000.00 was budgeted in the Water Fund to replace lead/galvanized lines. Currently, we've spent less than 5% of this budget item.

Re: Teal Lake Lighting Project

BACKGROUND:

The City of Negaunee Electric Department planned to provide enhanced lighting for pedestrian traffic along Teal Lake and Hungerford. This project was planned to take place in conjunction with the construction of the new Sports Complex. The cost for the Electric Department to purchase the lighting fixtures is \$20,500. The red lines below show the locations receiving enhanced lighting.



RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended by the Public Works Department that the City authorize the enhanced lighting project expenses in the amount of \$20,500 with monies coming from the Electric Fund Capital Outlay (582-605-970.000) The work is expected to be complete by the end of August 2022.

FISCAL EFFECTS:

In the 2022 budget, City Council had approved \$30,000 for enhanced lighting along Teal Lake.
